

Young Researchers Society for Flexible and Stretchable Electronics FSE Best Presentation Award Guidelines

1. This document defines the guidelines for the award given by the Young Researchers Society for Flexible and Stretchable Electronics to young researchers.
2. The purpose of this award is to honor the achievements of young researchers who have made excellent oral or poster presentations that contribute to the development of flexible and stretchable electronics at the Society's events by presenting the "FSE Best Presentation Award".
3. The award recipients are young researchers who have made excellent oral or poster presentations that can contribute to the development of flexible stretchable electronics at the events of the Society, and who have not yet received the Society's awards. And shall be a person who has the following qualifications.
 - (1) Young researchers registered with the Society
 - (2) Being the first author of oral or poster presentations
 - (3) Those who are registered speakers and who actually gave presentations
4. A list of award recipients will be posted on the Society's website.
5. A certificate with the name of the president of the Society will be presented to the awardee.
6. Winners will be decided by the examination of the review committee consisting of Ph.D. holders.
7. The number of awards is limited to 10% of the number of general submissions.
8. This guideline may be amended with the approval of a majority of the assistants of the Society.

Supplementary Provisions
